

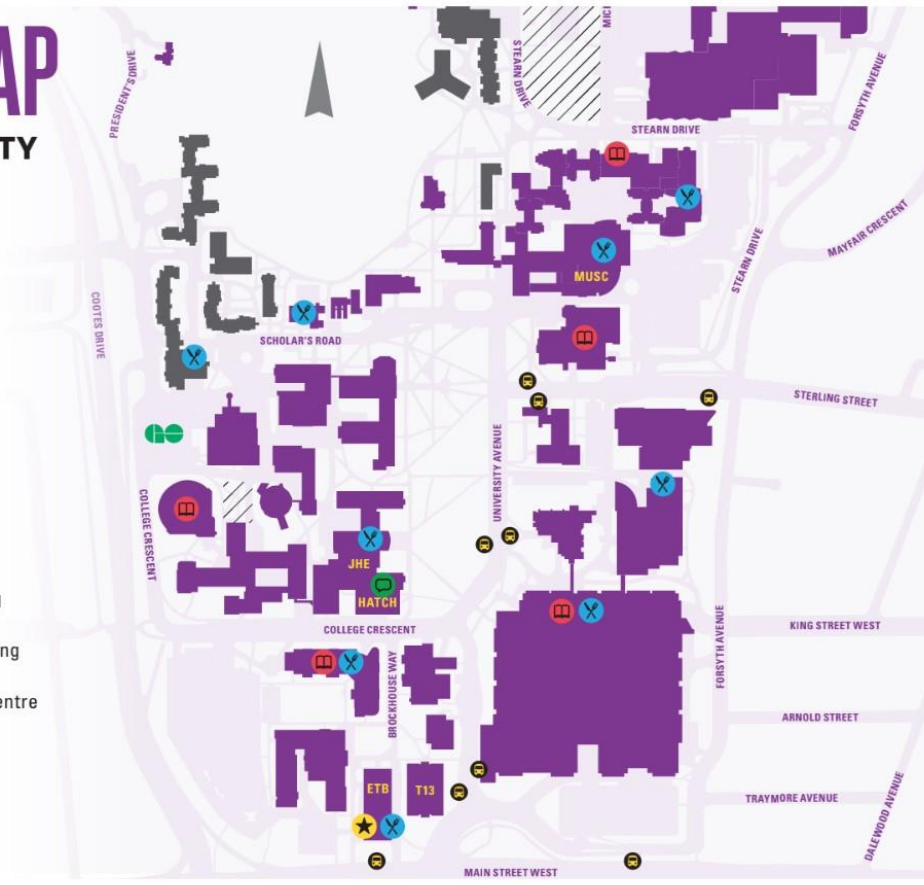

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE BACHELOR OF TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

The Bachelor of Technology program has 3 components; the B.Tech. Degree, a related Advanced College Diploma, and an ACBSP accredited Business Management Certificate.

The B.Tech. program was created out of the need to meet industry hiring demands. It is designed to have a flexible curriculum that updates based on emerging technologies and trends.

All B.Tech. students must complete 12 months of co-op before their final semester. Contact ECCS to get your co-op registered.

There are 7 streams of B.Tech. The university entrance streams are Automation, Automotive, and BioTechnology. The degree completion (DCP) streams are Civil Infrastructure, Power and Energy, Manufacturing, and Software. All of these streams are a part of the McMaster Engineering community, alongside Computer Science and the many CEAB accredited Engineering Programs.

Unlike other university faculties, B.Tech. professors focus on student learning rather than research. Also, most professors and instructors have had previous careers in industry.



GUIDE TO CAMPUS



The **Engineering Technology Building (ETB)** is the home of B.Tech. This is the glass building that faces Main St. W. However, you may have classes all across campus, including but not limited to; ABB, JHE, and DeGroot.
